

Harbor Committee Minutes

Meeting held via Zoom

- A. Meeting called to order at 1630.
- B. Minutes from June 22, 2021.
Motion By Bright to approve the minutes as presented, seconded by Johnston. Motion carried.
- C. New Business
 - 1. Greg Johnston emailed committee reporting North and South dock ramp/abutment project on track and should be ready for bids soon. Committee asks that he be present for next meeting.
 - 2. The Harbormaster reports that 2020 was up compared to years past and 2021 will surpass and all previous years in terms of revenue. Moore asks for better marking visible to vessel operator on public and commercial docks, along with slip identification visible higher on pilings. Bright asks for the pick/up drop off to be better marked to prevent people from tying up for longer periods. The Harbormaster said he would look into what can be done.
 - 3. Zoom meeting guidelines were discussed. Motion by Bright to adopt as presented, seconded by Johnston. Motion carried.

General Issues.

- 1. Motenko updated committee on parking survey. The subcommittee will be reviewing and will bring recommendations for next year.
- 2. Chairman Savage informs committee of floats out of compliance in harbor, Litchfield also informs of an additional one as well. The Harbormaster is going to address the issue.
- 3. Chairman Savage asks about the pile of traps located by the launching ramp. The highway garage is due to do a pick up anytime, per Harbormaster.
- 4. The Chairman and committee express condolences to the passing of Dana Haynes. The committee acknowledges his dedication a service to the town and community, a truly great man.
- 5. Moore brings to the attention of the mooring expansion outside of the harbor and the non-compliance to the harbor ordinance section 7.5 and encroachment into navigable waters.
- 6. Bright mentions the overcrowding of public floats and dingy dock in seal harbor. Motenko mentions boats at the dinghy dock that are too large for the spot.
Motion by Motenko to adjourn, seconded by Moore. Motion carried 1721.
