- A. Meeting called to order at 1632
- B. Minutes from last meeting approved
- C. New Business
 - The harbormaster reported that the season went well considering all factors. The Marina Slip rentals seem to be on par and the mooring rentals picked up after a slow start. The island Explorer not running made more parking available for the use of the marina.
- D. General Issues.
