## The Town of Mount Desert and MDI are doing a great job with distancing and masking. Let's stay vigilant in our collective efforts!

The Town of Mount Desert expects residents and visitors alike to abide by CDC and State recommendations for <u>mask wearing</u>, <u>social distancing</u>, <u>quarantine</u>, <u>isolation</u>, <u>and handwashing</u>. Abiding by these recommendations will help protect our island community.

The Governor's mandate requires Maine people to wear cloth face coverings in public places where physical distancing is difficult to maintain, as recommended by the US CDC.

## **Covid Transmission Update**

- MDI Hospital confirmed that they have had 9 positive tests to date.
  - 4 Hancock County, 5 other (visitors/non residents)
- As of today 8/27/20, Maine CDC has confirmed 46 positive cases in Hancock County.
- The current case rate for the State of Maine is 33 per 10k people
- The current case rate for Hancock County is 8.4 per 10k people
