## **Covid Transmission Update**

- MDI Hospital confirmed 33 positive tests to date, with the most recent positive on 12/2
  - 27 Hancock County residents
  - o 6 (non-residents)
- As of today 12/10/20, Maine CDC has confirmed 344 positive cases in Hancock County
  - This is an increase of 57 cases since 12/3, the previous week saw 63 new cases
  - The current case rate for the State of Maine is 111 per 10k people
- The current case rate for Hancock County is 62.8 per 10k people
