 - 12/17 455 positive cases
 - 12/10 344 positive cases
 - 12/3 298 positive cases
 - 11/26 235 positive cases
- The current case rate for Hancock County is 100.3 per 10k people
- The current case rate for the State of Maine is 180.8 per 10k people
