- As of today 2/18/20 Maine CDC has confirmed 866 positive cases to date in Hancock County.
 - 2/11/20 835 positive cases
 - 2/4/21 807 positive cases
 - 1/28/21 766 positive cases
 - 12/31 550 positive cases
 - 11/26 235 positive cases
- The current case rate for Hancock County is 158 per 10k people
- The current case rate for the State of Maine is 322 per 10k people
