Due to overwhelming call volumes, MDI Hospital is asking anyone who is able to assist family members, friends and neighbors in pre-registering online to help ensure that our phone lines remain available for our patients.

- The next Board of Selectmen Meeting February 1, 2021 6:30pm
- 1/27 /21 from Bar Harbor Fire Chief Matt Bartlett:
  - The Bar Harbor Fire Department is working in conjunction with Peninsula Ambulance Service in Blue Hill to <u>vaccinate all of Hancock County's First Responders</u>. To date, Bar Harbor Fire has administered 100 first dose vaccines to all EMS personnel on MDI and outer Islands, Island Police Officers, dispatchers, and a portion of the island firefighter. A vaccine clinic is planned for February 3rd at Atlantic Oceanside to finish vaccinating all firefighters on MDI and firefighters in all the communities North and East of Ellsworth. Today we started administering 10 second dose vaccines to Island EMS personnel.
