- MDI Hospital confirmed that they have had 25 positive tests to date.
 - 25 Hancock County residents
 - 6 (non-residents)
- As of today 11/19/20, Maine CDC has confirmed 192 positive cases in Hancock County.
 This is an increase of 55 cases since 11/12.
- The current case rate for the State of Maine is 72.7 per 10k people
- The current case rate for Hancock County is 35 per 10k people
