- Covid 19 is on the rise in Maine and in Hancock County.
- MDI Hospital confirmed that they have had 12 positive tests to date.
 - 6 Hancock County residents
 - 6 (non-residents)
- As of today 10/27/20, Maine CDC has confirmed 69 positive cases in Hancock County.
- The current case rate for the State of Maine is 47.2 per 10k people
- The current case rate for Hancock County is 12.6 per 10k people
