## Covid Transmission Update

- MDI Hospital confirmed that they have had 10 positive tests to date.
  - 5 Hancock County residents
  - 5 (non-residents)
- As of today 10/06/20, Maine CDC has confirmed 55 positive cases in Hancock County.
- The current case rate for the State of Maine is 41.6 per 10k people
- The current case rate for Hancock County is 10 per 10k people
