Town Clerk Joelle D. Nolan called the meeting to order at forty-five minutes past seven o'clock in the forenoon, June 11, 2013. Printed copies of the Warrant were made available.

**Article 1A.** To elect a Moderator by written ballot.

Town Clerk Nolan called for nominations of moderator. By motion and second William Ferm was nominated to serve as Moderator. A written vote was conducted, three votes were cast for Mr. Ferm, and he was duly declared Moderator. Town Clerk Nolan swore in Mr. Ferm as Moderator. Moderator Ferm appointed and swore in Joelle Nolan as Deputy Moderator.

Moderator Ferm declared the polls open at eight o'clock in the forenoon. Voting on Article 1 and Article 2 took place until eight o'clock in the evening, at which time Moderator Ferm declared the polls closed. Votes cast were counted, and Moderator Ferm announced the results at thirty-two minutes past eight o'clock in the evening.

**Article 1.** Do you favor approving the Mount Desert Island Regional School District budget for the upcoming school year that was adopted at the latest District budget meeting?

*A "NO" vote will discontinue the budget validation referendum for at least three years and provide instead that the Mount Desert Island Regional School District annual school budget shall be finally adopted at a meeting of the voters of the Mount Desert Island Regional School District.*
